Dream workshops are now offered as a two-course sequence of INTRODUCTION TO YOUR DREAMS and WORKING WITH ARCHETYPES IN DREAMS. The first course will introduce methods of observing, recording, and interpreting dreams, basic Jungian archetypes in dreamwork, developing information about your inner life from dream content, and responding to dreams' messages. This course is a required prerequisite to the second course, which will be led by Joel. The second course will focus more on the transpersonal or spiritual content of dreams. The emphasis here will be on viewing dreams as portals to that sacred dimension of consciousness where insight and guidance may be received from archetypal figures and themes. It is designed specifically for spiritual seekers who are seriously committed to pursuing a path of transcendence.

Only the introductory course will be offered this winter term. At present the group is full, but we are starting a waiting list in case of cancellations and for spring term. Linda and Diana will co-lead the winter group. About a month before the start of a dream workshop, people on the waiting list will be contacted in the order in which they signed up. 
